

Notice to stakeholders towards transition under GNA Regulations, 2022 and amendment thereof

- **Closure of ongoing application portal under Connectivity Regulations, 2009**
 - NSWIS portal has already been closed for submission of fresh applications **w.e.f. 5th April 2023** with start of applications under GNA Regulations.
 - NSWIS portal for re-submission of reverted application shall be closed **w.e.f. 24:00 Hrs. of 18th April 2023**.

- **Processing of transition cases**
 - Status of entities for transition shall be considered as on date of coming into effect of the GNA regulations **i.e. 5th April 2023**.
 - Entities shall submit the request for surrender/conversion for transition under the GNA regulations through letter/applicable application FORMAT available on CTU website through offline mode within one month from date of coming into effect of the GNA regulations.
 - While processing above applications/requests, inter-se priority shall be considered as per the original application date.

- **Processing of Stage-I applicants/grantees**
 - Stage-I connectivity applicants/grantees, who have not applied for stage-II connectivity by **5th April 2023**, may apply afresh as per GNA regulation along with applicable fees.

Provided that original application fees submitted earlier by Stage-I connectivity applicants/grantees shall be refunded, if the fresh application for connectivity under GNA regulations is submitted by **4th May 2023**.
 - Inter-se priority of such applicants/grantees shall be determined with reference to their date of above fresh application under GNA Regulations.
